JANUARY EVENT RECAP: PORT MODERNIZATION PROGRAM

Rory Respicio, Port Authority of Guam (PAG) General Manager, provided the main presentation at our virtual January General Membership Meeting covering the Port's modernization program.



The Port's 2013 Master Plan (MP) Update summarized the evolution of change in the PAG's modernization program and provided a "roadmap" to guide the modernization and future development strategy for the Port of Guam over the next 20 years.

After having completed over 70% of the projects identified in the 2013 MP Capital Improvement Plan (CIP), PAG Management determined that based on Governor Lou Leon Guerrero's goals and objectives for the PAG in preparation for the military buildup and organic growth, a 2020 Master Plan Update was required. The MP Update would enhance core capabilities in achieving resiliency and update the implementation strategy based on financial, operational and sustainability needs. Other enhancements would preparation of documentation to support the Public Utilities Commission adoption of any recommended tariff changes.

The following are planned modernization initiatives for 2019 - 2022:

- New Crane Acquisition Program
 - ◊ 2 new Ship-to-Shore Gantry Cranes
- JDE World Migration to JDE EnterpriseOne
 - ◊ Financial Management System upgrade
- Port Wharves Assessment & Upgrade
 - ◊ Assess and develop scopes of work to repair and upgrade all revenue generating Port wharves
- Customs Inspection Feasibility Study
 - ◊ Study factors for a inspection facility to enhance core capabilities
- Solar Power Energy Feasibility Study
 - ◊ Photovoltaic panel system on rooftop of several Port buildings.
- Deep Draft Wharf Improvement Project Feasibility Study
 - ◊ Construction of 1,500 liner foot deep-draft wharf,
 - ◊ Fill approximately 17 acres of reclaimed land in 3 shallow embayments within Apra Harbor.
- Fuel Connectivity Pipeline System for F1 & Golf Piers
 - ◊ Installation of pipeline between two critical Port piers to ensure fuel distribution remains uninterrupted.
- USACE Agat Bay Regional Shoreline Assessment
- New Admin. Annex Bldg. Construction and Old Admin. Bldg. Renovation (Bond funded project)
