SPEAKER'S BIOGRAPHY

Jeffrey W. Roesel AICP Executive Director of the Regional Planning Commission

Jeff Roesel is the Executive Director of the Regional Planning Commission. Jeff's primary responsibilities include the overall management, direction and coordination of all of the activities of the Regional Planning Commission as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the New Orleans, Slidell, and Mandeville-Covington, and South Tangipahoa Urbanized areas and its staff, as well as other program initiatives of the Commission.

In his thirty plus year career, Jeff has led many transportation initiatives, and as worked in many aspects of transportation in the New Orleans region.

Jeff was a Transit Planner for the Regional Transit Authority (RTA) and was the Project Manager for the Planning and Environmental Phases of RTA's Canal Streetcar Line, and the Riverfront Connector project that connected Canal Street to the Riverfront Line and changed the gauge of the Riverfront Line to match St. Charles and Canal Street lines.

Jeff worked in the private sector as a Transportation Planner at local and national engineering companies, was a Hub Supervisor with UPS, and as a Team Chief in the 214th Engineering Installation Squadron of the Louisiana Air National Guard.

Jeff is a graduate of the University of New Orleans, with a Masters Degree in Urban and Regional Planning. He is a Certified Planner (AICP) from the American Planning Association, and has served on the Board of several organizations including the Louisiana Public Transit Association (LPTA), Louisiana Planning Council (LPC), and the UNO Transportation Institute (UNOTI).
