Special Projects Branch

Mission & Function

- ▶ Execution of programs and projects formally known as “Support for Others”, “Environmental Support for Others”, and “Interagency and International Services (IIS)”
- ▶ Branch is responsible for assembling project delivery teams to manage reimbursable funded customers



Five Business Sectors

- 1) EPA (Superfund and Technical Support) – Remediation Services
- 2) Inter-agency/International Support (Non-DoD Federal Agencies) – Construction, Architect – Engineer Services, and Remediation Services



Five Business Sectors – Cont.

- 3) Fuels (Defense Logistics Agency – Energy) – Construction, Architect – Engineer Services, and Remediation Services
- 4) Facility Systems/Repairs/Maintenance (Military Installations and other DoD Agencies) – Construction



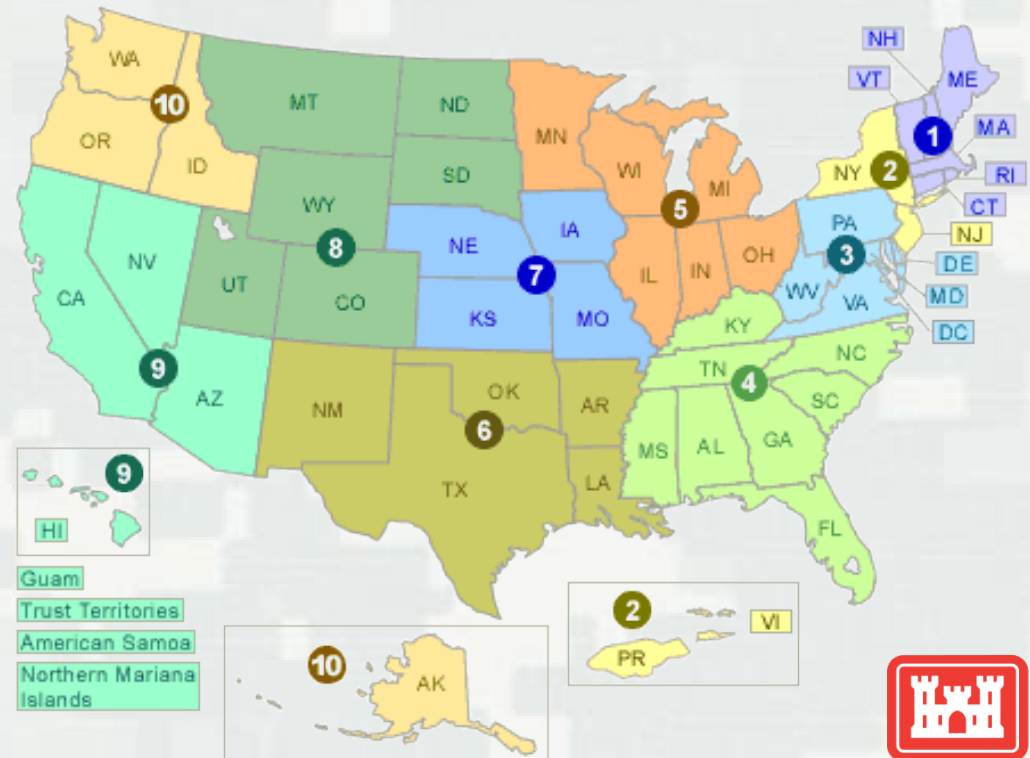
Five Business Sectors – Cont.
